ADVICE OF SHIRE WORKS

The Shire advises that the following works are in progress or programmed to commence in the near future. Please note all works are subject to weather conditions, therefore dates may change.

BALINGUP-NANNUP RD, BALINGUP – Authorised clearing of vegetation, shoulder maintenance and drainage.

Locality: Two sections approx. 6slk to 10.5slk and 13.5slk to 18slk (measured from the South Western Highway, Balingup).
Commencing: Late September 2015.

GOLDEN VALLEY TREE PARK, BALINGUP – Construct gravel carpark bays.
Commencing: Late September/Early October 2015.

JAYES RD, BALINGUP – Various sections of shoulder maintenance, drainage maintenance and widening of seal on narrow sections.

Locality: From South Western Highway intersection to Prowse Rd.
Commencing: Early October 2015

CHARLEY CREEK RD - Authorised clearing of vegetation, shoulder and drainage maintenance and repair failed sections.

Locality: One 3km section starting from the Donnybrook-Boyup Brook Rd intersection
Commencing: Early October 2015

DONNYBROOK AMPHITHEATRE CAR PARK & FOOTPATH –Construct sealed car park and pathway

Commencing: Early/Mid October 2015

Hours of operation are normally between 7.00 am and 5.00 pm, Mon to Fri. Works will be clearly signed and you are requested to exercise due care when travelling near or through these areas.
