The Shire of Donnybrook-Balingup would like to advise that line-marking of the parking bays on the main street and various public car parks in the Donnybrook town site is scheduled to commence on Monday 27th October 2014 (weather permitting).

## New Truck for Thomson Brook will make fire-fighting safer

The new 4WD truck was delivered recently as part of the Shire's fire-fighting equipment replacement program. It carries 3000 litres of water and comes equipped with drop down fire curtains in the cab, alloy panels (in place of plastic) and protected wiring. These features make it a safer vehicle than the 1997 model it replaces.

"Fire fighters are trained not to put themselves in danger, but should they find themselves trapped in a 'burn over' the fire curtains could potentially save lives," Shire CEO John Attwood said.

Bushfire Brigade vehicles are funded through the Local Government Grant Scheme from the Emergency Services Levy.

Mr Attwood said anyone interested in becoming a volunteer fire fighter should contact their local brigade or the Shire, but to report a fire they should call 000.



## Dog Registrations Due

Dog owners are reminded to re-register their dogs by October 31, after which Shire Rangers will be doing spot checks to ensure registrations are up to date.

All dogs over three months old are required to be registered by law and penalties apply for non-compliance. It is also a requirement for your dog to wear a tag with a name and contact details on its collar. These measures ensure your dog can be returned if it is found.

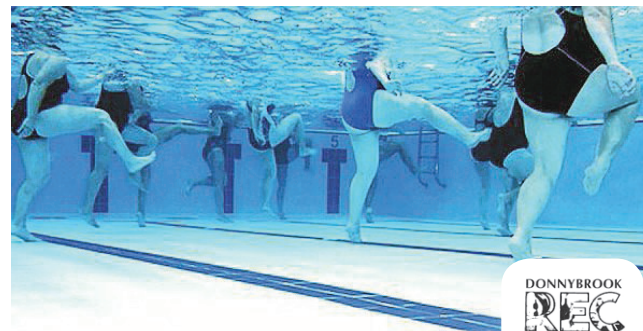
