INTRODUCTION

Recovery should be managed and planned for in a structured manner. The broad needs created by the impact of an emergency or disaster on the Shire of Donnybrook - Balingup community will only be met through a range of services, provided by a range of both government and non-government organisations.

At the local level, the focus of recovery planning and management is on community input. Within emergency planning responsibilities, the Shire of Donnybrook - Balingup local arrangements will incorporate recovery planning and, from an operational point of view, a range of services, including both infrastructure and human services. These arrangements will assist in providing coordination for the activities of local agencies.

The primary focus of the Shire of Donnybrook - Balingup Local Recovery Plan is to mitigate the effects of disasters. Within this context, recovery is defined as:

The coordinated process of supporting disaster affected communities in the reconstruction of physical infrastructure and restoration of emotional, social, economic and physical well-being.

Recovery is best achieved when the affected community is able to exercise a high level of self-determination.
