1) Administrative Centre

Advice was provided regarding the progress of this project and points of detail relating to design. It was advised that submissions can be made before the end of June.

2) Balingup Library Location

A number of options for an alternative site were discussed. This included sharing with the school or renting from the Packing Shed. These options will be investigated.

3) Possible Site for Historical Exhibition

An opportunity was discussed to relocate the library to the Packing Shed and share space with the historical exhibition.

4) Balingup Vintage Units

This item would be discussed further when more information is available.

5) Rural Residential Infill Strategy

This item was discussed and is linked to recent Council direction regarding Rural Residential infill densities and the initiative to amend Local Planning Scheme No.7.

6) Blackwood River Recreation Precinct

A progress update was provided on this study. A consultant has been engaged and the inception meeting has been completed. The consultant is now working on the first phase of the project which involves meeting with stake holders.

7) Amendments to LPS7

Council has instructed the CEO to prepare an item on how to best address rural residential infill subdivision densities. Once prepared, it will be publically advertised with all existing rural residential land owners being directly contacted by mail for comment.
