#### **6. DISCUSSION**

Brett Belstead, Director South West Operations, Main Roads WA updated the committee on the following items:

##### **1. Upgrading South Western Highway from Marginata Drive to Reserve Street**

This has been broken into two sections:

- a) Marginata Road to Anchor & Hope Inn, is identified in next four year program. MRWA are keen to have work carried out in summer of 2016. Roads will have sufficient width for cyclists.
- b) Anchor & Hope Inn to Reserve Street: MRWA are still designing this section – a few hurdles to overcome.

##### **2. Speed limit on southern and northern approaches into Donnybrook**

- a) Northern Section: No plans to change at this stage. This will be revisited when roadworks are completed.
- b) Southern Approach: As there is little pedestrian traffic south of Victory Lane the warrant for a 50kph speed limit does not exist.

##### **3. Pedestrian crossing**

The volume and flow of pedestrians across SW Highway would not warrant a zebra or pedestrian crossing.

#### **4. Truck parking in Kirup**

MRWA propose to undertake upgrading works in Kirup in 2016/17. There is an expectation that Council would be required to contribute towards the provision of truck parking – a figure of \$10,000– 15,000 should be allowed by Council in that year.

#### **5. Line marking, SW Highway and Victory Lane**

MRWA will assess the need for a white line in this area.

#### **6. Donnybrook-Boyup Brook Road**

Widening work is currently being undertaken. Proposal is for this work to get to Mumballup in the next couple of years – then past Noggerup.

#### **7. Newlands West Intersection**

Proposed for work in the 2016 summer – will include minor widening and barriers.

#### **8. South Western Highway – Donnybrook to Greenbushes**

In the next four years. Program includes a number of passing lanes / upgrades.

#### **9. Truck parking in Donnybrook**

MRWA offered no solution to this issue.

#### **10. Break down area for extra mass vehicles**

MRWA offered no solution to this issue.

Updates were provided on:

##### **1. Decorative apples (Ayers Gardens)**

The cost to repair and repaint the six green apples is \$7,500. The cost to repaint the apples on the northern approach is \$820. This will be expended from 2014/15 budget.

##### **2. Collins Street – Traffic calming devices**

As it is likely that Council will be able to attract significant Black Spot Funding for upgrading Collins Street in 2016/17, it was suggested that temporary re-usable traffic calming be undertaken in 2015/16 using the Townscape or Roadworks budget.
