# **5 GENERAL BUSINESS**

#### 5.1 Financial Performance

#### 5.8 General Business.

# Country Local Government Funding

- Cr Steve Dilley advised the group that the Shire has approved the reallocation of \$647,112 of Country Local Government funding to works on the Donnybrook Rec Centre. These funds will be used to:
  - 1. Approximately \$250,000 to replace the stadium roof;

- 2. Approximately \$150,000 to the replace the pool hall roof; and
- 3. The balance towards an upgrade of the gym.
- The committee is keen to be involved in further discussions regarding concept designs for the gym and group fitness areas.
- The committee also expressed a strong recommendation to consider the replacement/upgrade of the lighting and 'air circulation' in both the stadium and pool hall.

# Operating Hours

• The committee supports the decision to maintain the extended hours of operation of the Centre and recommend further internal and external advertising be done.

### **Memberships**

- Following a discussion of membership, the committee recommend a review of the current Gold Pass and Gym Membership to include a 12 month option on both. To be incorporated into the 2016/17 budget.
- Following a discussion about new membership markets and the potential to crosspromote the memberships to clubs using the Centre, it was agreed that the Centre staff will workshop the idea of a 'trial voucher system' as a means of encouraging existing Centre users to consider becoming a 'member'.

# **Group Fitness Program**

• The Committee commended the new DL 'group fitness timetable' and recommended that the Living Longer Living Stronger program be added.

# Suggestion Box

 The committee recommended the introduction of a 'Customer Suggestion Box'. Staff to reintroduce a 'suggestion form' and a locate a box in the Reception area.

### **Publicity and Promotions**

The committee noted the publicity and promotions conducted over the last 12 months.
It was also suggested that Centre staff re-approach the schools in respect to obtaining
space in the school newsletter to assist with the promotion of Centre programs,
especially those aimed at children/youth.
