



New 40km/h Speed Limit in effect on roads surrounding the Apple Fun Park, Donnybrook (December 2025)

The new 40km/h speed limit applies to the areas of Reserve Street and Collins Street as marked on this map. Other key landmarks are also highlighted for reference.

1 Reserve Street

40km/h speed limit applies

The length of road that starts at the South Western Highway and intersects with Collins Street, between the Apple Fun Park and the main entrance of the Pump Track (does not include the portion of Reserve Street that continues towards Donnybrook Transit Park)

2 Collins Street

40km/h speed limit applies

The length of road from the intersection with Reserve Street (immediately next to the Apple Fun Park and opposite the Pump Track) continuing approximately 350m south, ending near Park Donnybrook and before Bentley Street

3 Apple Fun Park

4 The Pump Track & Egan Park

Immediately opposite the Apple Fun Park (after intersecting with Collins Street, Reserve Street continues towards Donnybrook Transit Park, Men's Shed, Community Garden, etc.)

5 Park Donnybrook Station Square & Goods Shed

6 Donnybrook District High School (DDHS) & the Donnybrook Community Library
