OUR WASTE FACILITIES

Donnybrook Waste Management Facility:
3293 Goodwood Road, Donnybrook

Balingup Waste Transfer Station:
21370 South Western Highway, Balingup

Both of these waste facilities are operated by Hastie Waste - you can contact either location on (08) 9731 0296 during open hours. Alternatively, speak with the site attendant when you visit, or you can contact the Shire to discuss your query further.

For current site hours, refer to the Shire website. Both facilities are closed on Christmas Day, New Year's Day and Good Friday, and will be open on all other public holidays unless otherwise stated.



GENERAL WASTE

What goes in the bin with the red or dark green lid?

- Plastics (bags, storage containers, packaging, glad wrap, polystyrene, food wrappers)
- Food-soiled materials (includes teabags and recyclables like paper, cardboard or glass)
- Nappies, tissues, paper towels, wet wipes, small bins/baskets (cane, wood, plastic)
- Household items and utensils (plates, cookware, cutlery, straws, stationery)
- Clothes, blankets, shoes (if in good condition, consider reusing or donating)
- Pet waste (food packaging, hair/fur, manure/droppings, small diseased animals)
- Personal hygiene and health products (soap, band-aids, bandages, empty pill packets)



RECYCLING WASTE

What goes in the bin with the yellow lid?

- Bottles, jars, cans: empty + lids off (glass, aluminium, plastic, non-silver lined cartons)
- Glass: drinking cups, window panes, broken glass (use clean paper/cardboard for safe disposal)
- Cardboard: empty + clean (containers, rolls, flattened boxes - includes waxed cardboard)
- Paper: unshredded + clean (gift wrap, newspapers, paper bags, envelopes)



Remember: Recyclables must be free of food waste + unsoiled!

Food can't go in your Recycling bin, meaning that even if it's on a recyclable material, it will need to go in General waste instead. Make sure it's clean before you put it in this bin!



FOGO WASTE

What goes in the bin with the lime green lid?

- **Food Organics (FO)** - includes meat, seafood, fruit and veggie scraps, bones, eggshells, bread, dairy, loose tea leaves, coffee grounds, and out-of-date food (unpackaged)
- **Garden Organics (GO)** - includes garden waste such as grass clippings, plant cuttings, leaves, flowers, weeds, small branches and twigs (take large amounts to a Drop-off Point)
- **Approved/certified compostable bags** - includes caddy liners used to collect food scraps and produce bags (from supermarket or purchased separately)
 - Keep in mind that "biodegradable" or "eco-friendly" does not mean compostable. These items contaminate green waste systems, and should go in General waste instead.

How can you tell if it's actually a certified compostable bag?

LOOK FOR THE AS4736 CODE + SEEDLING ICON!



These markers appear on certified compostable bags, which are allowed to go in your FOGO bin. If you can't see either of them, put it in General waste instead.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Some extra advice & important reminders for the community

Still unsure about what goes where?

- Dispose of **large amounts of waste** at your nearest waste management facility
- **Consider repurposing or donating items** you no longer use that are still in good condition, or try out a DIY activity with the kids to pass on responsible waste sorting habits!
- **Batteries, phones & phone accessories** are a fire risk and can't go in kerbside bins
 - Bring them to the Shire Administration Office or another location that accepts these items for disposal instead
- **Some materials** can't be disposed of in kerbside bins or at local waste facilities, and instead must be taken to a designated **Drop-off Point**
 - Examples: fire alarms, chemicals, oils, paint, gas bottles, fluoro lights, e-waste, aerosol cans
